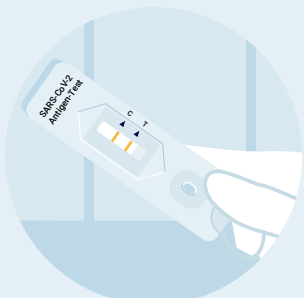


What tests are available for detecting a coronavirus infection?

Self-test

The antigen self-test allows you to test yourself. The result is available within 15–30 minutes.

You do not receive any formal confirmation of the test result.

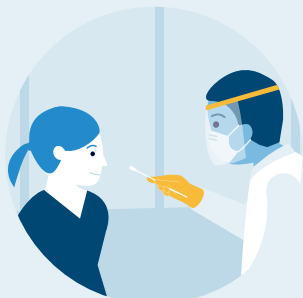


Positive result =
suspected coronavirus infection

Rapid test

Qualified personnel take a sample and analyse the antigen rapid test directly on-site. The result is available within 15–30 minutes.

You receive written or digital confirmation of the test result.

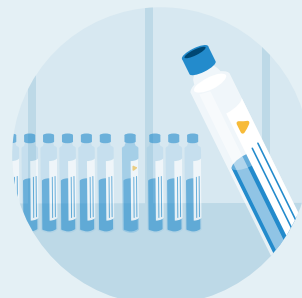


Positive result =
suspected coronavirus infection

PCR test

Qualified personnel take a sample. The PCR test is analysed in a laboratory. The result is usually available within 24 hours.

You receive written or digital confirmation of the test result.



Positive result =
proof of coronavirus infection

Options

i Precautionary test

to test yourself as necessary, e.g. before a scheduled meeting with family members, or as part of regular testing

i Precautionary test

as part of regular testing, e.g. at work, at school or child-care facility, or as required before visiting public places and facilities

i Diagnostic investigation

if you have symptoms, have come into close contact with an infected person or following a positive result from an antigen self-test or rapid test

Isolate

+ Continue to observe the "Hands. Face. Space. Fresh Air" and other hygiene rules
+ Test result is sent to the relevant health authorities.
