## **General Decree of the district of Rendsburg-Eckernförde**

### **on measures to combat the spread of the SARS-CoV-2 coronavirus and to determine the areas in which a mouth and nose cover must be worn in accordance with Section 2a Paragraph 2 Clause 1 of the State Ordinance to Combat the SARS- CoV-2 Coronavirus**

According to §§ 28 Paragraph 1 Clause 1, 28a Paragraph 1 No. 2 Infection Protection Act (IfSG) in conjunction with § 106 Paragraph 2 General Administrative Law for the State of Schleswig-Holstein (State Administration Act - LVwG) is implemented in accordance with § 2a Paragraph 2 of the State Ordinance to combat the coronavirus SARS-CoV-2 of March 26, 2021, last amended on April 10, 2021, issued the following general decree:

1. In the publicly accessible areas specified in the annex, in accordance with Section 2a Paragraph 2 Clause 1 of the State Ordinance to Combat the Coronavirus SARS-CoV-2 of March 26th, 2021, last changed on April 10th, 2021, on the days of the week named in the annex as well as on It is compulsory for pedestrians to wear a face-to-face covering at the times of the day specified there. Exceptions and other requirements result from § 2a paragraph 1 and 2 of the state ordinance. People who do not wear a mouth and nose cover and for whom an exception does not apply are not permitted to enter, stay or use the publicly accessible areas.
2. At all train and bus stations, train stops and bus and train stops for local and long-distance public transport in the area of the Rendsburg-Eckernförde district, the

platforms, the stops, the access roads to the platforms and stops, in the station buildings and on the station forecourt according to § 2a paragraph 2 sentence 1 of the state ordinance to combat the coronavirus SARS-CoV-2, from 6 a.m. to 10 p.m. pedestrians must wear a mouth and nose cover. Exceptions and other requirements result from § 2a paragraph 1 and 2 of the state ordinance. People who do not wear a mouth and nose cover and for whom an exception does not apply are not permitted to enter, stay or use the publicly accessible areas.

3. This order comes into force on April 12th, 2021. It is limited up to and including April 9, 2021.
4. The general decree is based on Section 28 (1) sentence 1, Section 28a IfSG in conjunction with Section 106 (2) LVwG. Infringements are therefore administrative offenses according to § 73 Paragraph 1a No. 6 IfSG.
5. The orders are immediately enforceable in accordance with Section 28 (3) in conjunction with Section 16 (8) IfSG. Objections and actions for rescission against these measures have no suspensive effect.
6. The general decree and its reasons can be viewed during office hours in the Rendsburg-Eckernförde district, Kaiserstraße 8, 24768 Rendsburg.

### **Justification**

The legal basis for the measure taken is §§ 28 Paragraph 1 Clause 1, 28a Paragraph 1 No. 2 IfSG in conjunction with § 106 Paragraph 2 LVwG in implementation of § 2a Paragraph 2 State Ordinance to Combat the Coronavirus SARS-CoV-2 of March 26th, 2021, last changed with amending ordinance of April 10th, 2021.

According to Section 28 (1) IfSG, the competent authority takes the necessary protective measures, in particular those in Section 28a, paragraph, in the event that sick people, suspects or suspects or those who have been eliminated are identified, or that a deceased person was ill, suspected of being sick or who had left 1 IfSG and in §§ 29 to 31 IfSG mentioned, insofar as and as long as it is necessary to prevent the spread of communicable diseases. Necessary protective measures within the meaning of Section 28 Paragraph 1 Sentence 1 IfSG to prevent the spread of the Coronavirus Disease-2019 (COVID-19) can be carried out by the German for the duration of an epidemic situation of national scope according to Section 5 Paragraph 1 Sentence 1 IfSG Bundestag in particular the obligation to wear a mouth and nose cover (mask requirement), § 28a paragraph 1 No. 2 IfSG. In particular, it can oblige people not to enter public places or only under certain conditions.

The currently circulating SARS-CoV-2 virus is a pathogen that can lead to a communicable disease within the meaning of Section 2 No. 3 IfSG. The spread of the SARS-CoV-2 virus must be prevented in order to combat the pandemic. The scope of application of the 5th section of the Infection Protection Act is therefore opened.

The authorization according to Section 28 (1) IfSG is a general clause that obliges the competent authority to act. Necessary protective measures within the meaning of Section 28 (1) IfSG to prevent the spread of the coronavirus and to prevent further illnesses from COVID-19 according to Section 28a (1) No. 2, in particular, the obligation to wear a face mask (mask requirement).

To assess the likelihood of damage, the principle applicable in general police and regulatory law must be used, namely that the greater and more serious the damage that may occur, the lower the requirements for the likelihood of damage occurring. For this reason, measures can also be taken against persons other than the persons named in Section 28 (1) sentence 1 IfSG.

According to Section 2a Paragraph 2 Clause 1 of the State Ordinance on Combating the Coronavirus SARS-CoV-2 of March 26, 2021, pedestrians must cover their mouth and nose in pedestrian zones, main shopping areas and other inner-city areas, streets and squares with comparable public traffic in who typically cannot keep the distance requirement. The above-mentioned areas as well as the time restriction have been determined by the health department of the Rendsburg-Eckernförde district after prior consultation with the affected districts. According to the assessment of the local authorities, the order to wear a mouth and nose cover at the locations mentioned in the annex is absolutely necessary. In order to minimize the risk of infection, mouth and nose covering is urgently required in the areas named in the annex.

The aforementioned considerations also apply to the platforms, on the access roads to the platforms, in the station buildings and on the forecourt of the train stations, train stops and public transport stops in the area of the Rendsburg-Eckernförde district.

The measure is also required. No equally suitable, less burdensome measures are evident. This is especially true here because it is not possible to keep the minimum distance to other people at the places indicated in the annex for most of the time. In these heavily frequented areas, the distance requirement within the meaning of Section 2 Paragraph 1 Clause 1 of the State Ordinance on Combating the Coronavirus SARS-CoV-2 of March 26, 2021 cannot always be complied with. The areas in which the mouth and nose cover should be worn are clearly delimited by the designation in the appendix. The order is also limited in time to what is necessary in the opinion of the local authorities and the health department of the Rendsburg-Eckernförde district (time of day / day of the week). The timeframe primarily reflects the peak times in the respective spatial areas. In addition, Section 2a Paragraph 1 Clause 3 of the State Ordinance on Combating the Coronavirus SARS-CoV-2 of March 26th, 2021 applies, i.e. the mask requirement does not apply to children up to the age of six and people who have no physical, mental or psychological impairment. Wear a mouth and nose cover and make this plausible.

This order comes into force on April 12th, 2021. It is limited up to and including May 9th, 2021.

The general decree is based on §§ 28 paragraph 1 sentences 1 and 2, 28a IfSG in conjunction with § 106 paragraph 2 LVwG in implementation of § 2a paragraph 2 sentence 1 state ordinance to combat the coronavirus SARS-CoV-2 of March 26, 2020. Infringements are therefore administrative offenses according to § 73 Paragraph 1a No. 6 IfSG.

The orders are immediately enforceable in accordance with Section 28 (3) in conjunction with Section 16 (8) IfSG. Objections and actions for rescission against these measures have no suspensive effect.

The general decree and its reasons can be viewed during office hours in the Rendsburg-Eckernförde district, Kaiserstraße 8, 24768 Rendsburg.

### **Legal Appeal**

An objection can be raised against this general ruling within one month of its announcement. The objection must be submitted in writing, electronically or for recording to the district of Rendsburg-Eckernförde, Der Landrat, Fachdienst Gesundheitsdienste, Kaiserstraße 8, 24768 Rendsburg.

If a lawyer is involved or if the objection is submitted electronically by an authority, it can be sent to the special electronic mailbox of the Rendsburg-Eckernförde district via the special electronic lawyer mailbox or authority mailbox.

An objection by email is not permitted. Citizens can only lodge an objection to the special electronic mailbox of the Rendsburg-Eckernförde district if the citizen has a citizen EGVP account (OSCI account) and also uses a qualified electronic signature.

The objection has no suspensive effect in accordance with Section 80, Paragraph 2, No. 3 of the Administrative Court Regulations (VwGO). An application for an order of suspensive effect can be submitted to the Schleswig-Holstein Administrative Court, Brockdorff-Rantzau-Strasse 13, 24837 Schleswig, in accordance with Section 80 (5) VwGO.
